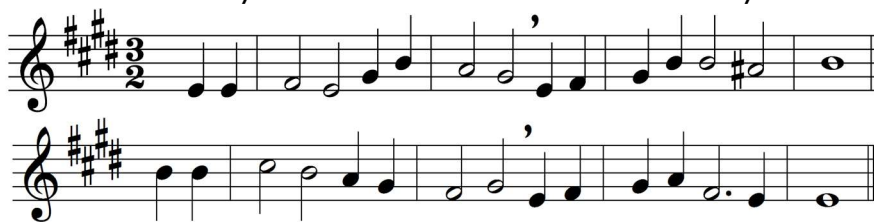


For the bread which you have broken AMNS 456 Melody: Omni die 8 7. 8 7.
