Editorial Conventions

The original clef, staff signature, mensuration symbol and first note of each part are shown on the prefatory staves at the start of the piece. Editorial accidentals are placed above the notes concerned and remain operative throughout the bar. The missing Tenor part has been reconstructed editorially in small notation.
