^{*}Noel is translated in this period in English by the [archane] form, "Noë," pronounced "no-ay"

Some sources indicate that an "Alleluia" may be substituted for "noë" but no underlayment is evident. However, the syllabication does not fit simply substituting syllable-for-syllable, hence resulting in a rhythmic emphasis counter to the triple meter. The suggestion may be from a later editor or copyist. I have chosen to maintain the original underlayment.
